 - 8th Grade Science- 38% proficient to 45%
 - 7th Grade Math- 28% proficient to 35%
 - 6-8 ELA- 48% proficient to 55%
 - State directed- ESE and ELL- goal 41%
 - ESE ELA PM 1- 9% proficient MATH- 21% proficient.
 - ELL ELA PM 1- 9% proficient MATH- 22% proficient.
